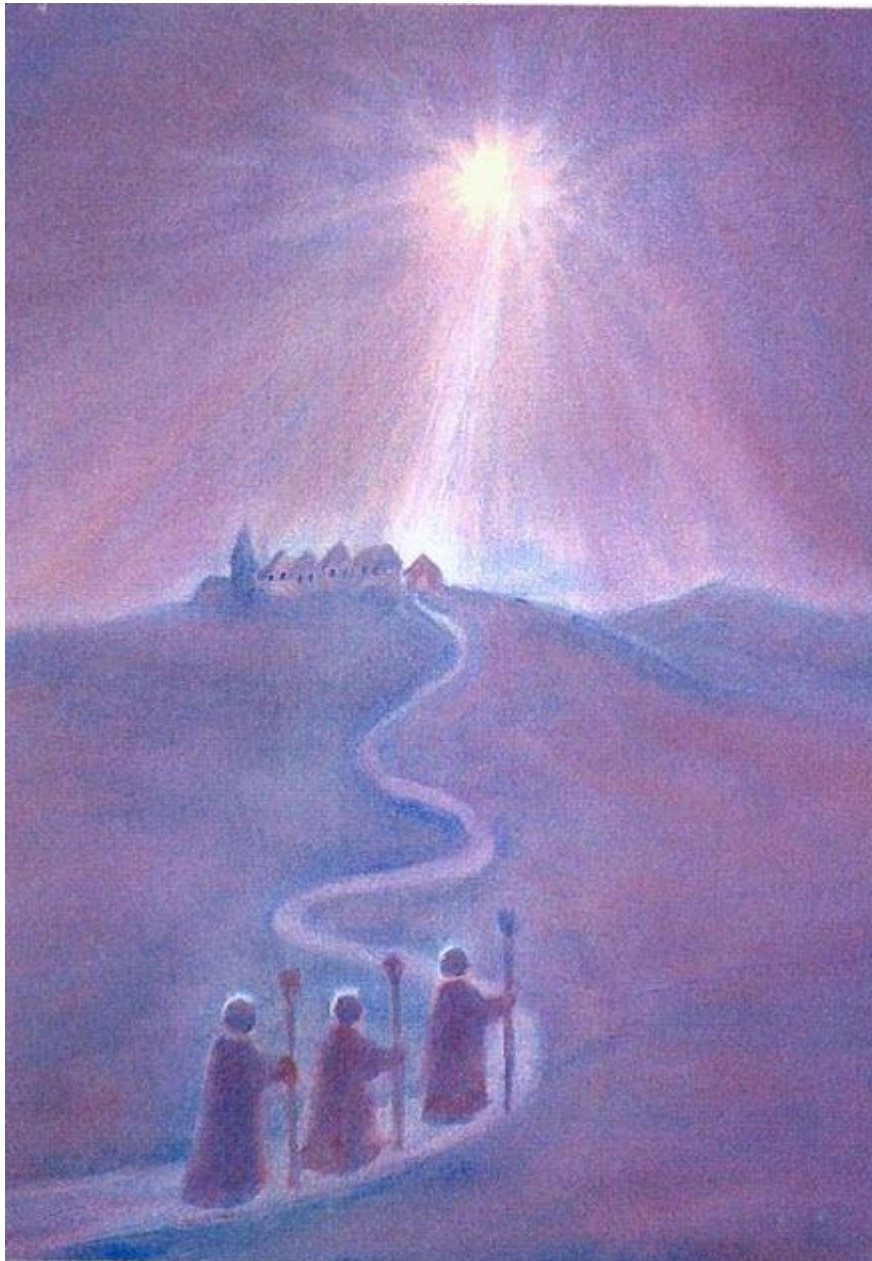

He worked for the Dutch NPI for Organisational Development from 1967, and has lectured in conflict at Salzburg University since 1985. He has written many books, including *Enterprise of the Future*. In 2014 he was awarded the Sokrates Award for Mediation by the Centre for Mediation in Cologne
