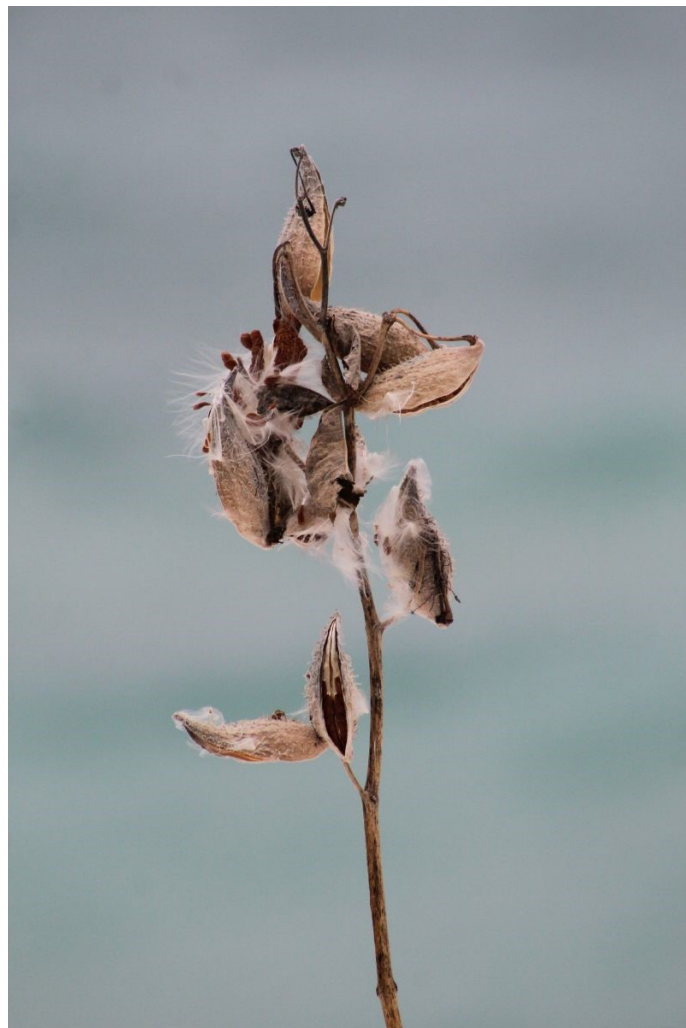

The Goetheanum – Housing the Spirit – with Alan Potter

Friday 28 February to Sunday Lunch-time 1 March.

A hundred years ago The First Goetheanum building was under construction and as the war in Europe ended, it drew many young people to the practical applications growing out of Dornach into the towns and cities of Middle Europe. The building spoke directly in a language of the esoteric. We will explore through illustrated lectures and through artistic work key elements of its development beginning in 1907, continuing through the construction, its 30 months of use, the fire of New Years Eve and its metamorphosis into word as the Foundation Stone Meditation. Rudolf Steiner spoke of how from 2086 similar buildings for our time would again be able to appear in the world. Course including tea-breaks, lunch on Saturday and materials -suggested **cost €70** (some reductions possible by arrangement). **Venue:** The Christian Community, Tuamgraney, Co Clare. Alan Potter has given courses on the Goetheanum for many years in the Botton Eurythmy School.

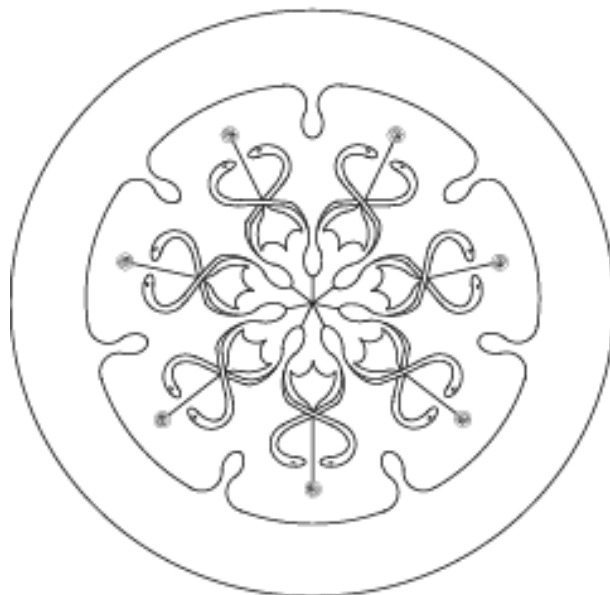
